CANVASS HEARING FOR CERTIFICATION OF SEPTEMBER 15, 2015
SENATE 45 SPECIAL PRIMARY RUNOFF ELECTION MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 17, 2015**

PRESENT: Chairman Joseph Arzillo; Commissioner Carl Tyler; Commissioner Lillian King; Commissioner Patricia Walls; Commissioner Donald Sheftall, Sr.; Commissioner Rodney Catterton; and Director Jeanine Bostick.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motioned by Commissioner Walls, seconded by Commissioner Tyler to approve the agenda for today's meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

ADMINISTER OF OATHS TO THE BOARD; CHAIRMAN AND DIRECTOR: Chairman Arzillo administered Oath to the Board and the Director. The Director administered the Oath to Chairman Arzillo.

CANVASSING HEARING: Chairman Arzillo began the canvass hearing. Two (2) Ballots were challenged, one from the Levy Precinct and one from the Pineland Precinct. The Board reviewed each challenged ballot. It was motioned by Commissioner King, seconded by Commissioner Walls to not count the challenged ballot from the Levy precinct. The voter did not present ID at the precinct nor at the canvass hearing. Motion carried unanimously. Motioned by Commissioner Sheftall, seconded by Commissioner King to count the ballot challenged at the Pineland precinct voter was in line at 7pm when the voting machine displayed close precinct. The poll worker did not understand that he could have exited that menu and a ballot would have displayed for the voter to cast his ballot electronic, therefore the ballot will be counted. Motion carried unanimously. Motioned by Commissioner Sheftall, seconded by Commissioner King to accept the new totals as the certified totals for the September 15, 2015 Senate 45 Special Primary Runoff Election. The election totals were certified and the motion carried unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT: With no further business motioned to adjourned by Commissioner Walls, seconded by Commissioner King. Meeting adjourned at 8:35am. Motion carried unanimously.
